Admissions 2021/2022 – Appeal Hearings – Bristol Hub

Applicants, who have had their application to Fairfield High School or May Park Primary School refused, have the right to submit an appeal to an Independent Appeal Panel and/or request to be placed on a waiting list.

Please note that applications to appeal must be received by 4 May 2021 when they are part of the normal admissions round for September 2021 for secondary places and 4 June 2021 for primary places and within 28 days from the date of the offer or refusal letter, at all other times. Appeals are heard in June/July. Appeals lodged in late June or in July may not be heard until mid/late September.

Admissions 2021/2022 – Appeal Hearings – Hungerford Hub

Applicants, who have had their application to John O'Gaunt School or Lambourn Primary School refused, have the right to submit an appeal to an Independent Appeal Panel and/or request to be placed on a waiting list.

Please note that applications to appeal must be received by 31 March 2021 when they are part of the normal admissions round for September 2021 for secondary places and by 15 May 2021 for primary places and within 28 days from the date of the offer or refusal letter, at all other times. Normal Admissions Round Appeals will be held on **Monday 14th and Tuesday 15th June 2021**. Results of all appeals will be confirmed to appellants no more than two weeks after the hearing date.

Hearings for Appeals lodged outside of the Normal Admissions Round will be heard within 50 days of the appeal being lodged.

Contact should be made in the first instance with the relevant school.

Admissions 2021/2022 – Appeal Hearings – Marlborough Hub

Applicants, who have had their application to St John's Marlborough, Burbage Primary School, Easton Royal Academy, Great Bedwyn Primary School, Oare Primary School, Ogbourne Primary School or St Katharine's Primary School refused, have the right to submit an appeal to an Independent Appeal Panel and/or request to be placed on a waiting list.

Contact should be made in the first instance with the relevant school who will provide further details.

Please note that applications to appeal must be received by 30 March 2021 when they are part of the normal admissions round for September 2021 for secondary places and by 14 May 2021 for primary places and within 28 days from the date of the offer or refusal letter, at all other times.

Normal Admissions Round Appeals will be held on **Monday 14th and Tuesday 15th June 2021**. Appellants will receive 14 days' notice of their individual hearing. Results of all appeals will be confirmed to appellants no more than two weeks after the hearing date.

Hearings for Appeals lodged outside of the Normal Admissions Round will be heard within 50 days of the appeal being lodged.

Admissions 2021/2022 – Appeal Hearings – Reading Hub

Applicants, who have had their application to The Wren School refused, have the right to submit an appeal to an Independent Appeal Panel and/or request to be placed on a waiting list.

Please note that applications to appeal must be received by 29th March 2021 when they are part of the normal admissions round for September 2021 and within 28 days from the date of the offer or refusal letter, at all other times. Normal Admissions Round Appeals will be held on **Monday 14th and Tuesday 15th June 2021**. Appellants will receive 14 days' notice of their individual hearing. Results of all appeals will be confirmed to appellants no more than two weeks after the hearing date.

Hearings for Appeals lodged outside of the Normal Admissions Round will be heard within 50 days of the appeal being lodged.
