Excalibur is committed to provide all students with the information they need to help them develop healthy, nurturing relationships of all kinds including:

- ❖ Families
- ❖ Respectful relationships, including friendships
- ❖ Online and media
- ❖ Being safe
- ❖ Intimate and sexual relationships, including sexual health

These areas of learning are taught within the context of family life taking care to ensure that there is no stigmatisation of children based on their home circumstances (families can include single parent families, LGBT parents, families headed by grandparents, adoptive parents, foster parents/carers amongst other structures) along with reflecting sensitively that some children may have a different structure of support around them (for example: looked after children or young carers).

Each school has its own policy which has been consulted on within their own community, and an age-appropriate curriculum which reflects statutory guidance from the DfE (2020) Relationships Education, Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) and Health Education. All policies will be updated in line with the statutory guidance from the DfE for September 2026, Relationships Education, Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) and Health Education.
