



Admissions Appeals for entry to school in September 2026

Bristol Hub

Applicants, who have had their application to Ashton Park School, Ashton Vale School, Cabot Primary School, Compass Point Primary School, Fairfield High School, Luckwell Primary School, May Park Primary School or Redland Green School refused, have the right to submit an appeal to an Independent Appeal Panel and/or request to be placed on a waiting list.

Please note that applications to appeal must be received by **5 May 2026** when they are part of the normal admissions round for September 2026 for secondary places and **5 June 2026** for primary places and within 28 days from the date of the offer or refusal letter, at all other times. Appeals are heard in June/July. Appeals lodged in late June or in July may not be heard until mid/late September.

Appeal Hearings – Hungerford Hub

Applicants, who have had their application to John O’Gaunt School or Lambourn Primary School refused, have the right to submit an appeal to an Independent Appeal Panel and/or request to be placed on a waiting list.

Please note that applications to appeal must be received by **31 March 2026** when they are part of the normal admissions round for September 2025 for secondary places and by **15 May 2026** for primary places and within 28 days from the date of the offer or refusal letter, at all other times.

Appeals will be heard in May to July 2026.

Appeal Hearings – Marlborough Hub

Appeals will be heard June to July 2026.
